CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 4-0 home record, won all four of its games in the Clemson Baseball Invitational.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.6 runs per game and hitting .291 with a .386 slugging percentage, .414 on-base percentage and eight steals.
- The pitching staff has a 5.46 ERA, .224 opponents' batting average and 2.64 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .984.

WINTHROP OVERVIEW

- Winthrop, which has yet to play a road game and is averaging 8.4 runs per game, is led by first-year Head Coach Mike McGuire.

- The Eagles won one of three games against Villanova last weekend. They are hitting .312 and have a 4.71 ERA and .977 fielding percentage.
- Jaylen Hernandez is hitting .414 with two homers and 10 RBIs and Ethan Wilson is batting .345 with three homers and 13 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson's highest-scoring inning has been the third inning (13 runs).
- Clemson is hitting .338 with runners in scoring position.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 4-0 record, four saves, a 4.78 ERA, .210 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts in 32.0 innings pitched.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 7 in the nation by Baseball America and Perfect Game this week.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 18 weeks in 2024. It has a current streak of 21 top-10 rankings in a row.
- Clemson has a current 29-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least poll dating to the 2023 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.

- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciujo, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .435 with two doubles, 11 RBIs, seven runs, six walks, four hit-by-pitches and a .588 on-base percentage in seven games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all seven games.
- He has hit safely and has at least one RBI in all seven games as a Tiger.
- He is hitting .636 with runners on base and .750 with runners in scoring position.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.
